Following Physica C standards, your original final paper should be set in two columns **and should not exceed 2 pages** (for contributed presentations). Your original final paper and four (4) hard copies of your paper for review purposes, the completed offprint order form and copyright transfer form, and the manuscript on a disk should be (air)mailed to:


