



Bridge Investment Program (\$40B)

- \$12.5B (Bridge Investment Program). Competitive.
 Replace, rehabilitate, preserve, or protect most important and economically significant bridges.
- \$27.5B (Bridge Formula Program). Formula. Replace, rehabilitate, preserve, protect, and construct bridges on public roads.
 - \$4B (Off-System Bridges). Bridges owned and maintained by cities and counties.




